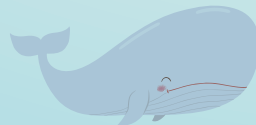

George the owl is travelling the world to explore earth's 5 biomes. Join his journey as he learns about what makes each habitat unique!

## Preschool ECO-EXPLORATION

Two Week Themes- Register Weekly.



### Week 1: June 17-June 21 Swinging in the Treetops!

Temperate

Temperate forests are the only biome to experience all four seasons-winter, spring, summer, and fall. George will learn why the plants of the deciduous forest shed their leaves and how animals adapt to the changing seasons. George feels right at home in this habitat, as Maryland is largely made up of temperate forests!

### Week 2: June 24-June 28 Swinging in the Treetops!

Rainforest

Did you know that most plant and animal species are found in the rainforest? George is going to love to explore the four zones of the rainforest and become friends with the Amazon parrot and the Great Caiman! In our weather study, we will learn all about rain and the water cycle.

### Week 3: July 1-July 5 Splish Splashing!

Salt Water

In the ocean biome, there is so much to see! We will learn about coral reef and George will meet a Blue Whale, the largest mammal in the world! In our weather study, we will learn about hurricanes!

### Week 4: July 8-July 12 Splish Splashing!

Fresh Water

George will get in his canoe and explore fresh water habitats—ponds, lakes, wetlands, and rivers. Even though freshwater is only a tiny portion of the earth's water, it is home to more than 100,000 species of plants and animals! George will make new friends as he meets turtles, frogs, and alligators, and otters along the way!

### Week 7: July 29-Aug 2 Arctic Blast

George is heading to the North Pole, but he will need some boots to walk across the permafrost of the Arctic Tundra!

### Week 8: Aug 5-Aug 9 Arctic Blast

George will visit with his relatives, the snowy owls, to learn about how animals in the tundra adapt to winter in the arctic--some have coats that change color and have thick fur on the bottom of their paws!

### Week 5: July 15-July 19 Party on the Plains

Did you know that grasslands biomes are home to the largest land animals? George will meet elephants, bison, hyenas and rhinos in the grasslands. George will learn about farming, since the grasslands are the perfect place to grow crops.

### Week 6: July 22-July 26 Party on the Plains

The intricate underground warrens built by prairie dogs are another fun place for George to explore! George will learn about the North American grasslands (prairies) and how they are different than the grasslands in Africa (savannas)!

### Week 9: August 12-August 16 Scales and Tails

Cold

Did you know that not all deserts are hot? This week, George will travel to the cooler deserts of the world--Antarctica and the Gobi!

### Week 10: August 19-August 23 Scales and Tails

Hot

Did you know that desert storms can carry dust for thousands of miles? George will visit the Sahara desert- the world's largest hot desert.
